



## Sport Premium

### ***What is Sport Premium?***

Sport Premium is an amount of money which the government has agreed to allocate to schools. It has been extended to this year. The funding amount schools receive is based upon the number of children of primary age the school has at January of that year. The sport premium is to be used to increase the quality & breadth of PE & Sport provision, and increasing participation in PE & Sport.

At **St. Joseph's RCVA Primary School**, we strive to promote healthy and active lifestyles and aim to provide sporting opportunities for all our pupils.

The 2015-2016 Sport Premium funding for St. Joseph's RCVA Primary School is £8270.

The money will be used for:

- 1) Investing in the Easington School Sport Partnership Service Level Agreement to provide the school with the following:
  - Liaise with the school to develop an annual bespoke P.E. & Sport action plan.
  - Providing curriculum support and high quality CPD for teachers, teaching assistants, NQT's, team teaching, twilights, professional development days etc.
  - Provision of High Quality Coaching support across a variety of sports.
  - A full organised annual programme of competitions/tournaments/festivals **in addition** to the National School Games.
  - Participation, inclusion and excellence opportunities.
  - Identifying the gifted & talented children in P.E & Sport
  - Provision of an after-school activity in every term in a variety of sports.
  - SSP Network meetings to support PE Co-ordinators / PLTs in their role developing PE & sport within their school.
  - Identifying opportunities for young leaders to practise their skills through volunteering in schools.
  - Assistance in the process of applying for national 'Kitemark' status for High Quality Provision of P.E. & School Sport.
  - Promotion and development of links to local sports club.
  - Sustain and grow the network of Change4life clubs.
  - Central co-ordination of school sport programmes in SSP area.
- 2) pay for a P.E. Apprentice
- 3) Extending the programme of football coaching all year (apart from Autumn 2 and Spring 1) for children across school from Reception to Year 6.
- 4) Transport costs for taking children to the numerous festivals across the year – Cross country/netball/Tag Rugby/Basketball/Cricket/Mini Tennis/indoor Football/Swimming Galas
- 5) Hosting Canon Gaughan Cup and Bishop Cunningham Cup Football Tournaments.

- 6) Promotion of small schools football league throughout the year
- 7) Promotion of St. Joseph's Annual Football Festival – trophies and medals and certificates
- 8) Purchase of new equipment to replace expendables – e.g. footballs

Impact: The Sport Premium Funding will impact on our school in the following ways:

- 1) Children will be encouraged to participate in festivals and represent their school
- 2) Participation levels will continue to increase as we offer more out of hours clubs.
- 3) Attendance of after school and lunchtime clubs will continue to increase
- 4) Staff will remain firmly committed to supporting P.E. and will continue to run after school clubs to promote a healthy lifestyle and well being throughout the year
- 5) Increased range of activities from pupil voice and School Council
- 6) Sports Crew members will continue to raise the profile of P.E across the school through writing about events.
- 7) Extending our links with sporting bodies
- 8) New equipment for all children giving them the opportunity to enjoy further healthy experiences out on the playground
- 9) Gain Silver Active Kitemark
- 10) More confident children in and around school. Raising self-esteem.
