Teams- Live Sessions

We would like to thank you for supporting your child with their home learning activities so far and reinforce the fact that we are fully aware of everyone's differing circumstances and commitments.

As we have communicated, since the beginning of our remote learning journey, our remote learning offer will evolve as children, families and staff become more confident with the use of the Teams platform.

We are pleased to inform you, that from Wednesday 3rd February, we will be moving to a new timetable which will include more live lessons and input for our children. These sessions, along with some pre-recorded sessions and all of the resources necessary for learning, will be available on Teams; where teachers will support the children to become familiar with using them on this platform. Additionally, for anyone who is unable to access Teams or the live sessions, the planning and resources will continue to be available on our school website in our Home Learning section
