All children will be given a book bag, these should be brought to school every day.

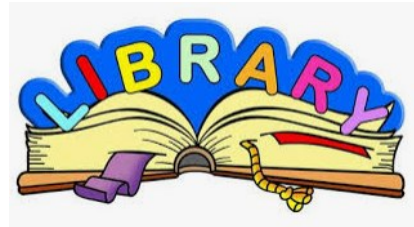
Little J's

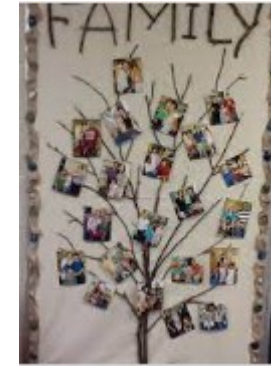
We are currently in the process of organising visits to the library and opportunities for parents/carers to come into school and share stories with your child. Watch this space!
