Breakfast Club

Breakfast Club will run from 7.45am-8.30am each morning and costs £2 per session. As usual your child's place at Breakfast Club will need to be booked. This can be done by completing the booking form that will be sent to you before we return to school.

Tea Time Club

Tea Time club will continue from September. It will continue to run based on 2 sessions. Session 1 is after school until 4.15pm at a cost of £1.50. Session 2 will run from 4.15-5.15pm and will cost an additional £3.50. Children will be provided with a snack e.g. sandwich, crisps and a drink.
